- Any breed with awards and less than 5 animals will be presented their awards as part of the AOB Show.
- Copies of the heifer registration papers must be included with the entries for proper processing!

2. May 1, 2008 – August 31, 2008
3. March 1, 2008 – April 30, 2008
4. January 1, 2008 – February 28, 2008

5. September 1, 2007 – December 31, 2007
6. January 1, 2007 – August 31, 2007 Cow w/without calf
7. January 1, 2006 – December 31, 2006 Cow w/without calf
8. January 1, 2005 – December 31, 2005 Cow w/without calf
9. January 1, 2004 – December 31, 2004 Cow w/without calf

Champion & Reserve Champion of each breed

Steer Classes:

1. STEERS CROSSBRED & PUREBREED
Steer show will have three divisions with a Champion and Reserve Champion of each Division. Followed by a Grand Champion and Reserve Grand Champion Steer. Classes will be announced after all steers are weighed.
2. Fryeburg Fair Scramble Calves
3. Cumberland Fair Scramble Calves
4. Angus Steers PUREBRED ONLY (Must have registration papers)
5. Hereford Steers PUREBRED ONLY
6. Belted Galloway Steers PUREBRED ONLY (Must have registration papers)
7. Group of Three Steers (Must be raised on one farm)

PLEASE NOTE:

- Entries close April 18, 2009. Late fees will apply.
- Incomplete entries will be charged a late fee.
- All exhibitors with cattle at the Beef Expo must provide proof of liability insurance with a minimum of \$1,000,000.00 coverage. This could be a commercial or homeowners policy (make sure it covers cattle off your farm).

Showmanship:

I am exhibiting an animal & would like to be entered into Showmanship

Novice – I am exhibiting an animal & this is the first time I have ever shown

I do not wish to participate in showmanship

Non-owned showmanship open to youth who do not have an animal exhibited, but who can borrow an animal not being used by another exhibitor
