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Sporting Breed Dogs

- _____ 1940, retrieves from boats, yellow eyes disqualification, handles any kind of game, marcel (uniform waves) to closely curled, solid liver, brown or dark chocolate. A little white on toes and chest permissible.
- _____ Dark coat absorbs heat very quickly so owners should watch for signs of overheating, Soft and shining, straight or slightly waved, but not curly, with long hair on ears, under stomach and on chest, Black with tan markings
- _____ 1906, coat is naturally straight flat and soft to the touch, never wiry or wavy, sufficiently dense to be waterproof, thorn proof, and weatherproof, rich red and white only
- _____ 1915, Coat is of moderate length density and fullness, with a high luster, solid black or solid liver
- _____ 1925, used in field trials, hunting, obedience, and as guide dogs for the blind, dense water repellent coat ranges in color from light to dark shades of gold, natural ruff; moderate feathering on back of forelegs and on underbody
- _____ 1930, hair is short and thick and feels tough to the hand, solid liver or a combination of liver and white such as liver and white ticked, tail is set high and firm, and must be docked
- _____ 1934 changed name from Brittany Spaniel in 1982, natural pointer and excellent retriever, Strong, vigorous, energetic and quick of movement, Dense, flat or wavy, never curly, Orange and white or liver and white in either clear or roan patterns. Some ticking
- _____ 1943, Short, smooth and sleek, solid color, in shades of mouse-gray to silver-gray
- _____ 1946, had been recognized as a variety of Cocker Spaniel, 1892 the Kennel Club (England) finally recognized them as separate breeds. Solid colors are black, liver or shades of red. Parti-colors are either clearly marked, ticked or roaned
- _____ 1959, coat is weather-resisting in every sense of the term, and it is to large extent water-repellent. It is straight, harsh, wiry, and quite flat-lying, liver and white, usually either liver and white spotted, liver roan, liver and white spotted with ticking and roaning or solid liver
- _____ 1960, also called a Hungarian Pointer, coat is short, smooth, dense and close lying, without woolly undercoat, Solid golden rust in different shadings. Solid dark mahogany red and pale yellow are faulty. White on the fore chest
- _____ Also called Italian Pointer, eyes and lips are framed by stiff hair, coat is dense, stiff and flat or slightly crimped, but not curly, with an absence of undercoat, Solid white, white and orange; orange roan with or without orange markings; white with brown markings, brown roan with or without brown markings.
- _____ Coat moderate length and flat, solid red, with no black, requires weekly attention to avoid mats,

- _____ curls stay in place with little to no attention, Black or liver, coat is water resistant
- _____ First dog used to stand game, coat is short, dense, smooth with a sheen, liver, lemon, black, orange; either in combination with white or solid-colored, In the darker colors, the nose should be black or brown; in the lighter shades it may be lighter or flesh-colored.
- _____ Flat without curl or wooliness. Feathering on ears, chest, abdomen, underside of thighs, back of all legs and on the tail of good length, white ground color with intermingling of darker hairs orange belton, blue belton (white with black markings), tricolor
- _____ From Newfoundland, strongly built, medium-sized, coat is short, straight and very dense, black, yellow and chocolate
- _____ Is the 150th AKC breed, lure, and retrieve waterfowl, water-repellent double coat of medium length and a soft dense undercoat, any shade of red, ranging from a golden red through dark coppery red,
- _____ Known as Shannon Spaniels, Rat-Tail Spaniels or Whip-Tail Spaniels, coats are double coat naturally water-shedding, Solid liver
- _____ Known for its prowess in rough, icy water, thick short slightly wavy coat, eyes that are very clear, of yellowish or amber hue, developed along the Chesapeake Bay
- _____ May be trained to work as a hunter, obedience dog or in tracking, Single; moderately long; flat or slightly wavy; silky; and glossy; dense and water-repellent, Black, liver, golden liver or shades thereof.
- _____ Originated in France, long, low, substantial dog, coat is dense, straight and flat, primarily a white dog with lemon color or orange color markings
- _____ Outer coat and an undercoat, with a fringe of feathering of moderate length , Black or liver with white markings or predominantly white with black or liver markings; Blue or liver roan; Tricolor: black and white or liver and white with tan markings
- _____ Particularly adapted for swampy country, double coat, straight and wiry, water resistance, steel gray with brown markings, frequently chestnut brown, or roan, white and brown; white and orange also acceptable
- _____ Rich golden liver color is unique to the breed, long and low, rectangular and rather massive appearance, coat is abundant, flat or slightly waved, with no tendency to curl.
- _____ Smallest member of the sporting-dog family, legs are well feathered, Black Variety, Parti-Color Variety, Tan Points, ASCOB
