Educational Objectives:

To provide a place for youth to compete regionally while encouraging teamwork and self-confidence and focusing on the 4-H Mission of Mandates of Science, Healthy Living and Citizenship.

To develop leadership by encouraging decision-making, teamwork, critical thinking and independence.

Awards:

- 1. For a state team to be considered for this award, they must have entries in at least two of the communications contests (public speaking, individual presentation, team presentation). Both the A team and the B team from each state may be considered for a team communications award.
- 2. A total score for each state will be calculated by adding the final scores for each contest entry.
- 3. Ties will be broken first by the combined judges' delivery scores, then by the combined judges' organization scores, and finally, by the combined judges' content and accuracy scores.
- 4. The top 8 teams will receive awards.
