Maine 4-H Working Steer Team

ESE Apprentice Guidelines

- 1. 4-H members between the ages of 10 and 18 (as of January 1st) will be eligible to join the ESE team as an apprentice.
- 2. The Maine 4-H Working Steer Team will invite a maximum of two apprentices each year, dependent on team size.
- 3. The ESE Coordinator will work with club leaders to determine which members will be invited to participate as an apprentice.
 - a. Preference will be given to members who attempt to qualify for ESE but do not have enough points or experience extenuating circumstances.
- 4. The members' club leader(s) must approve of the member attending ESE as an apprentice.
 - a. Consideration will be given to participation at club and working steer events, members attitude/sportsmanship, and willingness to participate in the team and related activities.
- 5. Apprentices will be expected to conduct themselves in a respectful and appropriate manner. It is important to remember that you are representing yourselves, your family, your club/county, the State of Maine, and the whole working steer program.
- 6. Apprentices will report to the ESE coordinator while at ESE.
- 7. Apprentices will travel to and from ESE with the team and will stay in the dorms for the duration of the Youth Working Steer Show.
- 8. Apprentices are expected to participate in team events/preparations, fundraising, and obtaining sponsors.
- 9. Apprentices will receive the same benefits as other team members.
 - a. Team Apparel for member and parents
 - b. Meals provided by the ASC for apprentices and parents while at ESE.
 - c. Daily gate and car pass for parents
 - d. Name and sponsor ads listed in the program book.
 - e. Recognition as a team member
 - f. Participation plaque from ESE
- 10. Apprentices will be expected to participate fully while at ESE.
 - a. Barn Duty (picking up manure, sweeping the aisle and tack area, feeding hay, empty wheelbarrows etc.)
 - b. Assisting with team chores
 - c. Assist members preparing for the show.
 - d. Interacting with the public
 - e. Additional participation may be requested by the ESE coordinator or team members.
- 11. Apprentices will be expected to bring appropriate attire for the weekend.
 - a. Proper footwear is required for assisting in the barn and walking to/from the dormitory.
 - b. Clothing should remain club neutral. As such team members will be provided with team apparel.
 - c. Clothing will be in clean taste and of appropriate lengths (for example, no crop tops or short shorts).
