

GUIDELINES FOR INDEPENDENT 4-H QUARTERLY REPORTS

Independent 4-H Members are required to complete Quarterly Reports so that the Extension Office can be kept informed about your activities and accomplishments, and so that you can get credit for meeting the requirements of Independent 4-H Membership as outlined in the "Standards for Independent 4-H Members".

In the left column, please write the name of each project you are involved in this year. Then in the right column , beside the project name, describe what you've been doing in that project. If you do not have room in the space provided, you may use more than one space. If you still need more room, use a second Quarterly Report sheet.

As you complete the requirements to participate in Topsham Fair, do a Community Service Activity, a Public Display or Demonstration, and a Health or Safety Activity, describe the activity in the space to the right of where these activities are typed into the form, then check off that activity in the space above your signature.
