The ownership and management of electric grids is of unusually high interest in Maine, as Mainers pay some of the highest rates for electricity in the nation. This talk places this discussion within a wider global shift and explores how foreign companies like ENMAX Corporation and Iberdrola came to play central roles in Maine's power system. More importantly, it highlights the impact of such foreign/private ownership on Maine workers and communities.
