If the answer is "yes" to any of the questions the participant will be asked to leave.

During the meeting all participants will be asked to:

- Wear a mask or face covering
- Maintain 6ft distance from people not in your family group

If a participant refuses to comply with these CDC recommendations, they will be asked to leave.

Hand sanitizer and extra masks will be available.

There will be no bathroom access or food provided so please plan accordingly.
