Hunter/Bow Hunter/ Boater Safety Policy

Students enrolled in a safety program at the University of Maine 4-H Camp & Learning Center shall receive their certification upon successful completion of their course. Students need to pass a written exam, and also demonstrate good judgment and safety throughout the entire program. Students will not be certified for the following reasons:

- Student demonstrates poor judgment by putting him/herself or others in an unsafe situation.
- Student repeatedly disregards direction from a Safety Instructor during the safety lesson or on the range.
- Student scores less than a 70 on the written exam.
- Any of our State certified Safety Officers does not feel the student has demonstrated readiness and safe practices.

Final decisions in these matters will be left to the discretion of the Camp Directors and the Maine State Department of Inland Fisheries & Wildlife Recreation Director.

Students are not permitted to bring firearms or ammunition to the UMaine 4-H Camp. (Exceptions can be made for archery equipment with prior permission of the Camp Director.)

All equipment will be provided by the UMaine 4-H Camp & Learning Center.
