

Bitter pit, biennial, rots, etc.

• Flavor complex, cider

Biennial tendency, don't overcrop

Jonagold

• Harvest *mid-late*

• Size *large*

• Color red blush


• Firmness firm-crisp

• Flavor *sweet-tart*

• Storage *yes, 1-MCP*

Under-planted, as good or better than Honeycrisp IMHO





Cripps Pink cv. (Pink Lady®)

• Harvest *very late*

• Size *medium*

• Color bright red-pink > 80%

• Firmness *medium-hard*

• Flavor *sweet-tart*

• Storage *I'd 1-MCP them*

'Maslin' and 'Barnsby' cvs. earlier maturing



Crunch Time Apple Growers

- SnapDragon and/or RubyFrost
- \$1,000 Share Purchase (up to 2 acres, \$500 per acre for more)
- \$875/acre (adjusted according to actual acreage)
- Tree royalty \$1.25 per tree
- Fruit royalty \$500/acre/year (no fee in year 1 or 2, \$250 in year 3, \$500 in year 4 +)





MAIA apples

- Midwest Apple Improvement Association
- \$100 annual membership
- Tree royalty due nursery (or permission to graft)
- Trademark fees are 20 cents per tree for years 4-10, and 30 cents per tree for years 11-20

• Harvest *early*

Color deep red burgundy

• Firmness *firm*

• Brix 12-14

• Flavor sweet

• Storage no

Very attractive, early, a winner but don't store...



Summerset® (MAIA12)

• Harvest early-mid

• Size large

• Color good but a bit dull

• Firmness *medium*

• Brix *12-13*

• Flavor sweet, mild

• Storage ?

Purported Honeycrisp alternative, verdict is still out IMHO...



Ludacrisp® (MAIA-L)

• Harvest *mid-late*

• Size *medium-large*

• Color 50%+ red blush

• Firmness *firm*

• Brix 14-16

• Flavor *different!*

• Storage ?

Tastes like 'licorice,' truly different, should be a winner but might be over-hyped...



Rosalee® (MAIA11)

• Harvest *mid-late*

• Size *medium*

• Color 75-90% red

• Firmness *medium-soft*

• Brix sweet

• Flavor *nothing special*

• Storage *no*

I have not been overly impressed...

• Color 25-50% red blush

• Firmness *medium-firm*

• Brix 13

• Flavor *meh*
