

ASSIGNMENT OF COPYRIGHT

OWNER AND 4HF AGREE THAT:

- 1) Owner owns the copyright, title, trademarks and all other related rights in and to his/her original work entitled (the "Work").
- 2) Owner does hereby sell, assign, and transfer to 4HF, its successors and assigns, the entire right, title and interest in and to the copyright in the Work, and in and to all works based upon, derived from, or incorporating the Work, and in and to all rights corresponding to the foregoing throughout the world.
- 3) If the Work is one to which the provisions of 17 U.S.C. 106A apply, the Owner hereby waives and appoints 4HF to assert on the Owners behalf the Owner's moral rights or any equivalent rights regarding the form or extent of any alteration to the Work (including, without limitation, removal or destruction) or the making of any derivative works based on the Work, including, without limitation, photographs, drawings or other visual reproductions of the Work, in any medium, for any purposes.
- 4) Owner will deliver to 4HF the completed Work in a form and content satisfactory to 4HF.
- 5) Owner warrants and guarantees to 4HF that the Work is original on his or her part, is not a derivative work of any other work, and is in no way a violation of, or an infringement upon, any copyright belonging to any third party.
- 6) This agreement constitutes the sole and entire agreement made between the

- 8) This Agreement is binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the respective successors and/or assigns of the parties hereto.
- 9) In the event that any one or more of the provisions of this Agreement are determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void, unenforceable or illegal, the remaining provisions of this Agreement shall continue to be in full force and effect.
- 10) This Agreement shall be governed and interpreted according to the laws of the State of Maine, except that its conflicts of law provisions shall not apply.
