







Crop Insurance Why?- Agriculture is Risky! 1. Farmer buys insurance through agent -> Insurance protects their average: crop yield or crop revenue -> Farmer decides coverage level (can never insure 100%)


Crop Insurance Why?- Agriculture is Risky! 1. Farmer buys insurance through agent 2. Premiums are subsidized but paid for by farmer Disaster hits... 3. Adjuster verifies claim 4. Farmer compensated





Form AD-1026 needed for all policies* Vield protection policies Crop yield records (4 yrs min) *can substitute county yield* Revenue protection Schedule F tax forms (3 yrs min) Sales records Inventory reports
