

Waldo County 4-H Achievement Award

The Waldo County 4-H Achievement Award is an award designed to recognize high achieving 4-H'ers in Waldo County who demonstrate outstanding project work, club participation, community action, personal engagement, and leadership. In order to be eligible for the award applicants must meet the following three criteria:

- 1. Be enrolled in Waldo County 4-H during the 2020/2021 4-H year.
- 2. Have a minimum of 80% club event attendance.
- 3. Submit a 2020 Waldo 4-H Project Record and 4-H Portfolio.

Awards will be given in two age divisions:

- Youth: 4-H ages 9-13
- Senior: 4-H ages 14-18

Awards will be given in three project areas:

- 1. Youth in Community Action which includes projects in
 - Civic Engagement
 - Leadership
 - Community Service
 - Service Learning
- 2. **STEM** which includes projects in
 - Science (including animal science)
 - Technology
 - Engineering
 - Mathematics
- 3. **Healthy Lifestyles** which include projects that demonstrate
 - Decision making
 - Action in healthy lifestyles and/or safety

Application Checklist:

- □ Submit 2020/2021 Project Record to Waldo County Extension Office by October 15, 2021.
- □ Complete Application for 4-H Achievement Award.
- □ Complete 4-H Portfolio (4-H portfolio cover page, 4-H resume, and 4-H story).
- □ Staple 4-H Achievement Award Application to the front of 4-H Portfolio and submit to the Waldo County Extension office by October 15, 2021.
