Examples of eligible fields of study include, but are not limited to agriculture, horticulture, crop science, animal sciences, natural resource conservation, environmental sciences, home economics, nutrition, food systems, preventative health, health education, youth development, and early childhood/youth/adult education.

**A single scholarship recipient will be announced by April 15th, with funds awarded following completion of a successful first semester.**
